SWU students must receive pre-approval to take exams and must make their own arrangements to test at a CLEP-testing center. Students must attain the minimum credit granting scores (no exceptions are made) to earn the credits and course equivalencies **listed below**. ***SWU score recipient code is 5896***. **SWU must receive the student's official CLEP score report or transcript directly from CLEP to consider awarding credit. For passing scores on acceptable exams, SWU currently charges a posting fee of \$50.00 per test. (Updated 7/8/11)**
