 - Course sequence requested in Education 1201
 - All courses will be completed prior to the Clinical Experience
- _____ 4. Effective Methods Class - must score 2.0 or higher
 - Receive a Basic (2) or above on Mini Lesson Presentation
 - Receive a Basic (2) or above on Evaluation from Public School Partner
- _____ 5. Oral Presentation - must score 2.0 or higher
