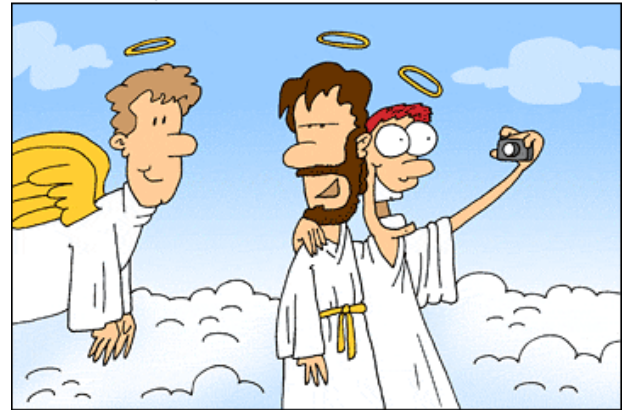
Hephzibah Children’s Home
