

# Comparison of MEd Programs

## Administration and Supervision

### Intended for:

Current teachers or interim administrators desiring to achieve advanced certification and placement as assistant principal, principal or district supervisor

### Features:

- Leads to advanced certification in South Carolina
- Includes three practicum experiences plus an internship
- All courses are seven weeks (plus breaks) except the final course (internship), which is 12 weeks
- Curriculum is lockstep with no electives

### Requirements:

- Valid South Carolina professional teacher's certificate
- Three years teaching experience
- Successful completion of an undergraduate program of study with a GPA of at least 3.0 (if less than 3.0, students must have satisfactory scores on the GRE and/or approval of the Graduate Admissions Committee)

## Classroom Leadership

### Intended for:

Current teachers desiring to enhance their preparation for classroom teaching and leadership

### Features:

- Non-certification program
- Includes only class work with no practicum requirements
- All courses are seven weeks
- Program includes six hours of elective credit, which can be transferred in or taken at the various AGS sites

### Requirements:

- Valid South Carolina professional teacher's certificate
- One year teaching experience or two recommendation letters (one from a school administrator stating that the student has access to a classroom for research purposes and one from someone who has knowledge of the candidate's ability to perform in an educational setting) stating that the student candidate has access to a classroom for research purposes
- Successful completion of an undergraduate program of study with a GPA of at least 3.0 (if less than 3.0, students must have satisfactory scores on the GRE or MAT test and/or approval of the Graduate Admissions Committee)
