Search Tips

Adjacency Multiple words are searched together as one phrase.
Example : world health organization

Wildcards Words may be right-hand truncated using an asterisk, "*" for 1-5 characters, "*" for open-ended truncation, "?" to replace a single character anywhere within a word.
Examples : environment* polic*, inter**?, wom?n

Boolean Operators Use "and" or "or" to specify multiple words in any field, any order. Use "and not" to exclude words.
Example : stocks and bonds
Example : (alaska or canada) and (adventure and not vacation)

Proximity Operators Use "near" to specify words close to each other, in any order.
Example : california near university

Field limits A field limit causes the system to search only the specified field for the specified word(s).

Grouping Keyword search results are usually grouped by relevance to bring the most likely titles to the top of the list. Each group represents a similar level of relevance and results are sorted within the group by date or title. To get an ungrouped result set, use boolean operators to form a complex query.

Look for subdivisions:

- o "Songs"
- o "Song cycles"
- o "Vocal music"
- o "Songs and music"
- o "Translations"
- o "Operas"

Finding Songs: Scores and Recordings

There are several good options:

1. Look up your composer in a song index (listed below) and see what collections include a score for your song. Use SWUcat to do a title search for the collection to see if we have it. If we do not, request the collection via interlibrary loan.
2. Look up your composer as an author in SWUcat with a keyword of "songs." Limit your search to "Southern Wesleyan Music Scores" under Location or "Sound Record" under material type. See example below.

3. Try a keyword search in SWUCAT for your song title. Sometimes the catalog record for song collections contains a note that gives the contents, and a keyword search will find that note.
4. Search by composer and/or title in *Classical Music Library* (Library web page > Click on "By Title" underneath "Locate Journal Articles and Online Resources.")
